

Progress and Attainment Measures

Average A8 grade is the average grade achieved by students across English, Maths, Science and their option subjects. An Average A8 grade of 4.6 means the average grade awarded to our students is roughly half way between a grade 4 and 5.

Progress 8 is a measure of how much progress, on average, students make across that same set of subjects. A progress 8 of +0.43 means our students are awarded GCSE grades that are almost half a grade better than students with the same key stage 2 results nationally. Due to the Covid pandemic, this result has not been published for 2020 or 2021
