 - Translate sentences and texts from and into L1 and L2. Develop accuracy of translation across multiple time frames. Beginning to apply decoding skills to identify unfamiliar vocabulary.

 - Write with reference to multiple time frames and develop comparative structures. Identify and respond to different purposes in writing.
