

Progress and Attainment Measures

Average A8 grade is the average grade achieved by students across English, Maths, Science and their option subjects. An Average A8 grade of 4.5 means the average grade awarded to our students is half way between a grade 4 and 5.

Progress 8 is a measure of how much progress, on average, students make across a specific range of subjects. A Progress 8 of +0.2 would mean that students, on average, secure GCSE grades that are 0.2 better than students with the same key stage 2 results nationally.
